**REFUGEES** The Nature in Art Museum, at Twigworth, has an exhibition "Migrations" which shows people who have fled war in the Middle East to come to Europe. The artist recognised the Mediterranean islands and coastlines shown on television during the crisis due to his expertise in tracking and painting migrating birds. He visited the camps, spoke with the people, gave art classes to the children and has produced a beautiful collection of paintings of people and birds and camps and boats. The collection will be displayed at Twigworth (GL2 9PA) until Sunday June 23rd.

**X-Site** for 7-11 year olds, supported and run by the churches of South Cheltenham in partnership with Scripture Union. A fun two hours of games, songs and stories with a biblical base will be running at St Christopher's large hall next Saturday 22nd June from 6pm—8pm.
