PARISH GIVING SCHEME

The Parish Giving Scheme (PGS) is a direct-debit system originally developed by the Diocese of Gloucester to provide a professional, effective donation management system to support parishes in funding their mission and ministry. The service is operated free of any charges, the whole amounts of all donations made through the scheme being passed through to the parish nominated by the donor. Furthermore, where the donation is eligible for Gift Aid, PGS will reclaim the tax from HMRC and pass this through to the parish once PGS has received it from HMRC.

PGS has announced the launch of a new telephone service, designed to enable prospective donors to set up a regular Direct Debit donation to their parish **over the phone**.

The service went live on **Monday 27th April 2020** and will operate weekdays between 9 - 5pm.

Prospective donors can set up a regular gift to their parish by calling the dedicated telephone line

0333 002 1271

One of the PGS administrators will take callers through the sign up process which normally takes around 15 minutes. A donor will need to have the following information to hand:

- Personal bank account details
- The name of the parish they wish to donate to: **The Church in Warden Hill**
- They will need to confirm if they want to increase their gift in line with inflation each year
- Confirm if they are eligible for Gift Aid

The PGS code for their parish (usually 9 digits in length): **160616244**
