Arson attack at St Andrew's United Reformed Church, Montpellier St, Cheltenham

On Wednesday 10th June 2020 the emergency services were called at about 9.10am. The Police and Fire Service attended.

According to the fire officer firefighters had been lit under the door late the previous evening and left. This is the original oak door of 1884 facing Fauconberg Road.

The fire had been smouldering all night causing damage to the central portion of both sections of the door to a height of about 7 ft. Smoke filled the building. Repair work is being organised along with an insurance claim.
