FOOD BANK UPDATE The Church in Warden Hill donated 55kg of food at Harvest Festival time. Thank you to everyone. Current needs include: washing powder (capsules are most useful as we can share them out among clients), coffee, milk, fruit juice, vegetarian meals, instant mash, tinned custard, sauces (ketchup, brown sauce and mayonnaise), shampoo and conditioner, shaving gel. They have lots of pasta, rice, soup, baked beans, pulses and cereal .
